

Truth can be defined as "sincerity in action, character, and utterance". Perhaps the most famous verse about truth in the Bible is what Jesus said:

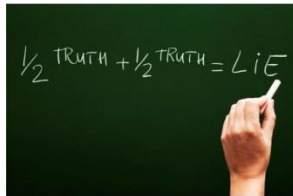
"... I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."
