#### Our aims

This leaflet is a summary of the aims of our school travel plan which sets out to;

- Improve childrens' journey to school on safer routes in the locality.
- Reduce car use and congestion in our car park by encouraging car sharing.

#### The School Travel Plan

The School Travel plan is a document which explains all the transport and journey needs of a school and details how provision can be made to promote and encourage sustainable travel to the school site.

#### @ Hewish

Children can be dropped off in the morning from 8.30am and go straight to class. This spreads the demand for car park spaces across 15 minutes.

#### Car drivers

At Hewish we have a small car park, so we ask all car park users to park considerately and within any designated parking bay, in order to maximise the number of cars we can accommodate.

# We ask that cars are not parked in the turning bay.

We have a car park attendant, who is there to ensure the safety of car park users and also to guide drivers to "hidden" car park spaces.

# Interested in car sharing?

Be brave! Ask another parent, you might be surprised by the response.

#### Minibus to the Full Quart

At the end of school, there are two minibus runs for up to 32 children on a daily basis. The minibus leaves school just after 3.15pm and drops off at The Full Quart pub car park. Places are allocated annually on a first come first served format. Parents are expected to collect their child from the minibus and use the Full Quart pub car park considerately.

Please remember that due to their height it is much harder for children to cross near or between parked cars than for adults. They simply cannot see on-coming traffic and other drivers cannot see your children!

We would like to encourage all our families to travel safely to and from school. In addition we aim to:


- improve children's health and vitality on their journey to and from school;

# Please drive slowly in our car park

- Speed is one of the biggest contributory factors in fatal road accidents.
- "A pedestrian struck by a car driven at 20 mph has a 95% chance of survival. This reduces to 80% if driven at 30 mph and 10% at 40 mph" DRIVE SAFELY.
- "7 out of ten mothers admit to regularly breaking the speed limit, while half admit to using a mobile phone when driving with their children in the car." Please be mindful of this
