

Our aims

This leaflet is a summary of the aims of our school travel plan which sets out to;

- Improve pupils' journey to school on safer routes in the locality;
- Encourage pupils to walk, scoot or cycle whenever possible;
- Reduce car use and congestion in the car park by encouraging car sharing.

The School Travel Plan

The School Travel plan is a document which explains all the transport and journey needs of a school and details how provision can be made to promote and encourage sustainable travel to the school campus.

The Options

Children can be dropped off in the morning from 8.20am ready for 8.30am start in class.

Walking

Local footpaths do provide safe opportunities to access the school, via Scot Elm Drive, De Salis Park and Newton Walk.

Scooters and Bicycles

Although it is difficult to cycle and scoot on some approach roads, local footpaths do provide safe opportunities for some routes to school. There is a cycle shelter and mini-scooter storage on site. Children are encouraged to wear safety helmets.

Car users

We would like to limit the number of cars on the West Wick campus. Why not look out for car sharing opportunities? Keep street parking orderly and avoid parking on footways and across drive ways.

Please remember that due to their height it is much harder for children to cross near or between parked cars than for adults. They simply cannot see on-coming traffic and other drivers cannot see your children!

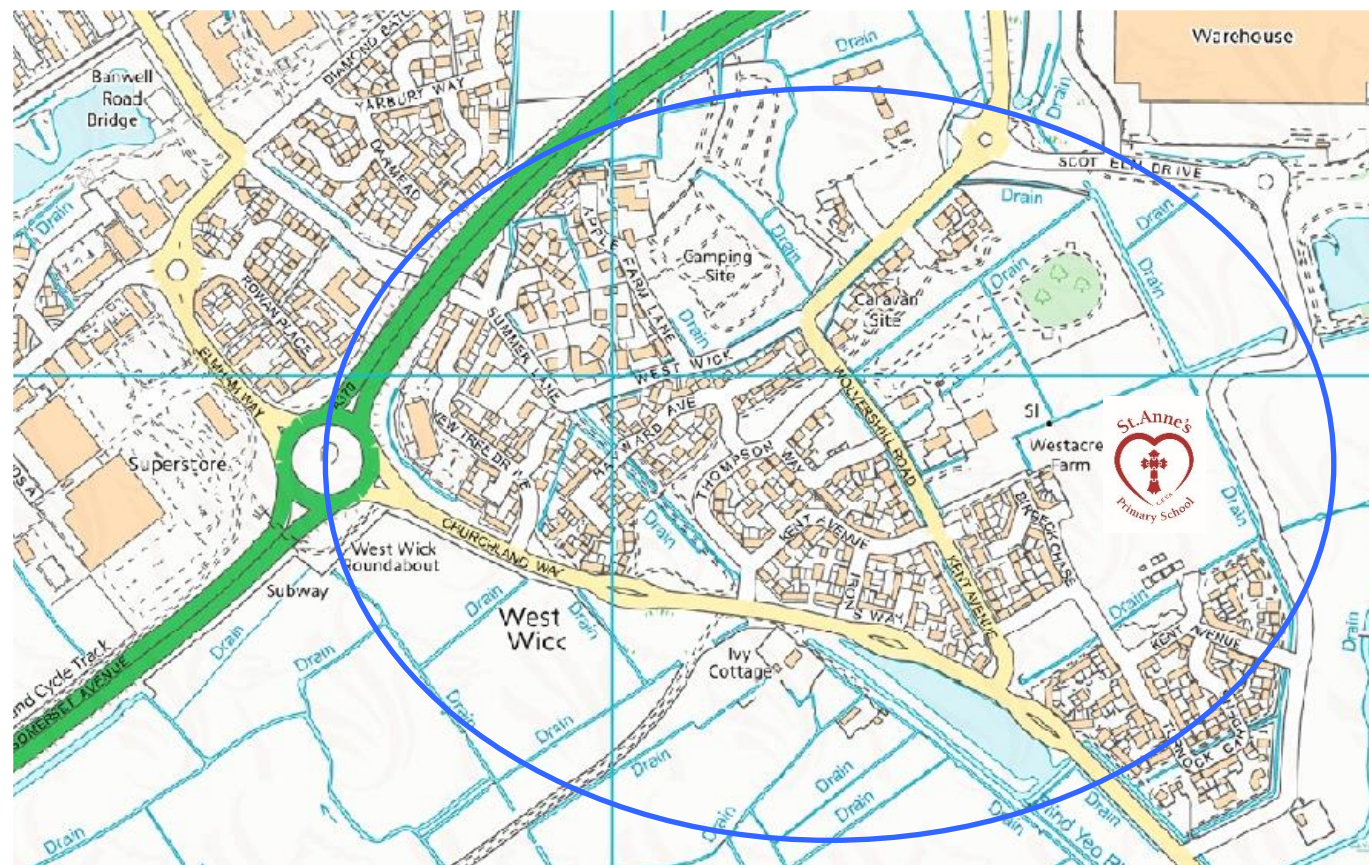
