In September, our Learning Theme will be:
How Green is our Planet?

Over the summer period, we have two challenges to help with our first enquiry questions. Please bring your projects into school the first week back in September and we will share them with the class.

1. What does it mean to be Green?

One of our first tasks **in school** is to create a mood board around the colour green. Start a collection of any green objects you can find which could be used on a mood board. Think about objects you would be able to easily attach to an A3 piece of card. Here are a few ideas:

- Cuttings from magazines
- Paint samples/swatches
- Pieces of material
- Feathers
- Pictures of green in nature

We are certain you can come up with some more creative ideas!



2. Where are the Greenest Places on Earth?

We would like you to create a piece of learning about the world's rainforests. You can choose how you present this learning. Here are a few suggestions:

- A poem
- A fact file
- A shoebox model
- A PowerPoint

- A poster
- A story set in the rainforest
- Or choose your own idea!

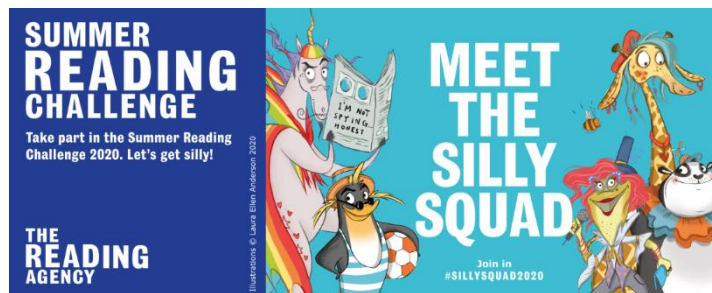
