### Learning enquiry:

Our learning theme is  
What's around me?

Research an animal that lives in the British country side.

Write facts about your chosen animal. Have a go at filming a documentary about your animal. You will need to read your facts and show diagrams of your creature.

If you go out and about you could take some photographs or draw some pictures of the things that you can see (man-made and natural).

You could also start a collection of natural things that you discover.

Then you can write some simple sentences about what you have observed.

### Extra Learning

Do some baking with the children as there is great maths and science language that can be developed in the process.

On rainy days, play a board game like Scrabble, Monopoly, Pictionary or even Snakes and Ladders! They are fantastic for spelling, counting forward and back from 100, letter and shape recognition skills.

Take the children on a picnic and get them involved with planning and writing the shopping list and preparing the food. They might want to make a kite to fly or draw flowers or insects while you enjoy the great outdoors!

Make sure there are spaces between words, sight words are spelt correctly and they have included the phonics sounds that they know. Ask your child to read back their sentences after writing to check that they make sense.
