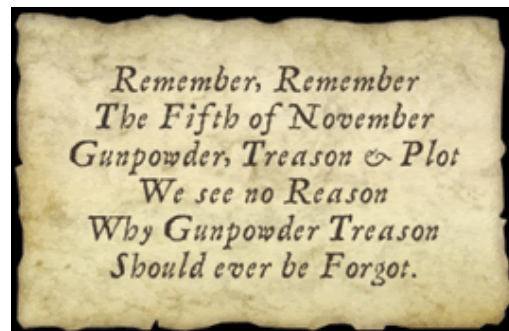


**Newsletter

Each session costs £3.50 or £4.25 including transport to Hewish. 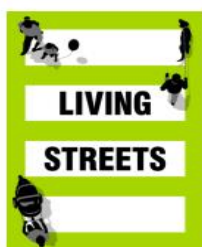
