# **ANTI-BULLYING WEEK**

Anti-Bullying week is a very important part of our school curriculum. This year it will be held from Monday 15th - 19th November. The theme is 'One Kind Word'. This fits perfectly with our term two PSHE topic 'Celebrating differences' and is a wonderful opportunity to come together and celebrate the importance of kindness. We would like children to come to school on Monday 15th November in school uniform and wearing 'one kind word' they have chosen - this can be a badge or drawn or printed onto paper and pinned on. There will also be stickers provided at school so no child will be missed out.


