COMMUNICATING WITH SCHOOL STAFF

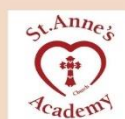
Can we ask that any emails to school staff be sent via the school mailbox please rather than individual staff emails. The email address for all communication is Mailbox@saca.theplt.org.uk
